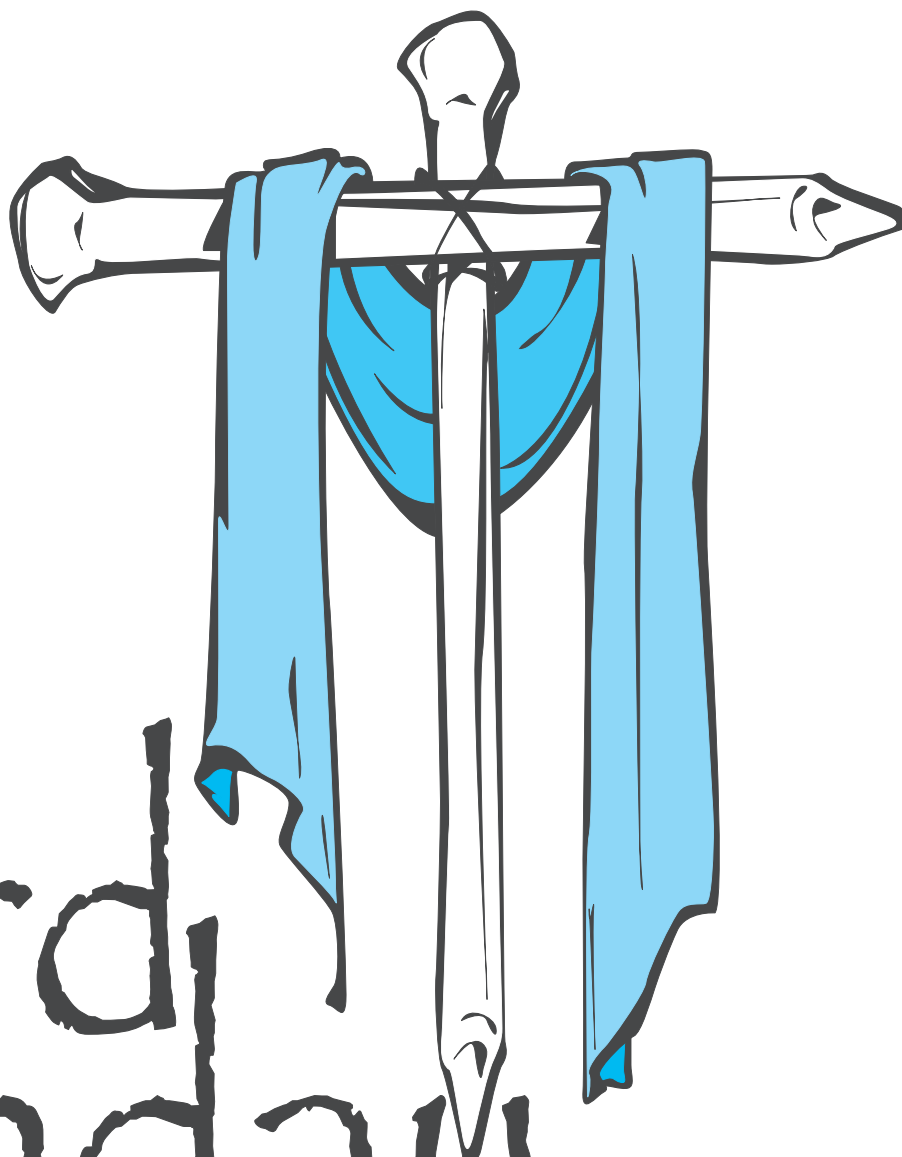

Every Catholic is to receive Holy Communion at least once between the First Sunday of Lent on February 21st and Trinity Sunday on May 30th unless a just cause would warrant some other time of year. (Canon #920)

Sunday School of Religion will meet on March 14th at 2:00 PM instead of the usual time. We will be attending the Communal Penance service at 3:00 PM in the Church. There will be NO class for 1st grade and under.

Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest

At the very core of the Christian life is the paschal mystery – the passion, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus Christ. Catholic communities celebrate this mystery when we gather in the breaking of the bread and in prayer. The Celebration of the Eucharist on Sunday is the "very core of the Christian mystery." (John Paul II, *Dies Domini*) But how do Catholic communities without a priest celebrate the paschal mystery on Sunday? The Church still calls the local community to gather and offer their praise and adoration to God in Christ, through the power of the Holy Spirit through the ritual of *Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest*.

Saint Olaf Catholic School will be celebrating our 50th Anniversary on June 5 and 6.
