





**Easter Duty**

Every Catholic is to receive Holy Communion at least once between the First Sunday of Lent on February 21<sup>st</sup> and Trinity Sunday on May 30<sup>th</sup> unless a just cause would warrant some other time of year. (Canon #920)

Our Parish Communal Celebrations of Penance and Reconciliation will be **TODAY** Sunday, March 14<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM and on Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM. There will be several priests available to hear your confessions.

Sunday School of Religion will meet on **TODAY** March 14<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 PM instead of the usual time. We will be attending the Communal Penance service at 3:00 PM in the Church. There will be NO class for 1<sup>st</sup> grade and under.

**Mass Intentions**

It is the custom of the Catholic Church that priests remember specific intentions at the celebration of the Eucharist. Normally, a small offering or stipend (customarily \$10 in the Diocese of Salt Lake City) is given for a Mass intention. Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered. Mass cards, to be given to the family of a deceased person for whom a Mass is to be offered or to be given to the living person for whose intentions a Mass is to be offered, are available when requesting a Mass intention. Requests can be made at the Parish Offices.

Does SCAP replace the Sunday celebration of the Eucharist? No, SCAP should not be regarded as the ideal solution for the shortage of priests, nor should it be seen as a convenience. SCAP is considered a temporary measure. Although reception of Holy Communion in a SCAP service is closely connected with the sacrifice of the Mass, it is not equal to it. Thus, it is always important at a SCAP to include prayers for vocations. However, when the celebration of the Eucharist is not available, attendance at SCAP does fulfill the Sunday obligation."
