**The Feast of Divine Mercy**

The Feast of Divine Mercy will be celebrated on Sunday, March 30, 2008, the first Sunday after Easter. There will be a special service of exposition and adoration of the Eucharist along with Benediction and praying of the Rosary and the Divine Chaplet at 3 PM that afternoon. **Everyone** is encouraged to make a special effort at attend this service.

Jesus made the following promise to Saint Maria Faustina : **“I want this image (the image of the Divine Mercy) to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy. On that day, the depths of My Mercy will be opened to all. Whoever will go to confession and Holy communion on that day will receive complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. Mankind will not enjoy peace until it turns with confidence to My Mercy.”**

You may go to confession a week in advance of the feast day to fulfill the requirement.

Our Lord revealed to Saint Faustina a powerful prayer that He wanted everyone to say— “The Chaplet of Mercy” and He urged her to encourage others to say it too, promising extraordinary graces to those who would recite this special prayer. The Lord specifically asked that it be recited as a novena, especially on the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. And He promised, “By this Novena (of Chaplets) I will grant every possible grace to souls.” You should start the novena on Good Friday, March 21st and end on Saturday, March 29th.

Pamphlets with the prayer for the Chaplet of The Divine Mercy and the Novena To The Divine Mercy are available in the rear of the church.
